

MilitarySuper Pension Recipients Re-Entering the Defence Force

(including People with Deferred Benefits in the DFRDB Scheme)

Who should use this form?

Please complete this form if you are in receipt of a MilitarySuper pension and intend:

- re-entering the Australian Defence Force (ADF) on continuous full-time service (CFTS) (including transferring from the Inactive Reserves to the Active Reserves)

People with Deferred Benefits in the DFRDB Scheme

Please also complete this form if you have a **deferred benefit in the DFRDB Scheme** that you have not claimed yet and you intend returning to the Defence Force **in the Reserve Forces for less than 12 months**. In this situation, the relevant scheme legislation requires you to join MilitarySuper.

Re-entry rules

MilitarySuper Contribution and Benefit Rules

- You will be required to contribute to MilitarySuper during your period of service.
- You will accrue both a Member Benefit and Employer Benefit in MilitarySuper.

Your MilitarySuper Pension

Your MilitarySuper pension is suspended during your period of ADF service. After your service ends, the pension will be updated based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI) and restored. Arrears of pension are not payable.
